OPEN FOR BUSINESS RESTRICTIONS

DUE TO THE CONTINUED LIMITED ACCESS THAT THE COMMUNITY HAS TO THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT BUILDING, BY THE WASHINGTON STATE STAY AT HOME ORDER. THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IS STILL OPEN TO SERVE THE PUBLIC WITH THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS:

- MEETINGS WILL NEED TO OCCUR BY TELECONFERENCE OR IN THE FIELD, BY USING SOCIAL DISTANCING, AND WEARING A FACE MASK.
- FOR PLATS, PERMITS, OR OTHER DOCUMENTATION THAT REQUIRES A SIGNATURE FROM COUNTY STAFF, AN APPOINTMENT CAN BE MADE TO OBTAIN THESE ITEMS. ALL APPOINTMENTS SHOULD BE MADE FORTY-EIGHT (48) HOURS IN ADVANCE TO ASSURE THAT THE NEEDED PERSONNEL ARE ONSITE.
- ANY APPOINTMENTS THAT ARE MADE SHALL BE KEPT WITHIN THE SCHEDULED TIME. APPOINTMENTS THAT CAN NOT BE ATTENDED AT THE SCHEDULED TIME WILL NEED TO BE RESCHEDULED, PLEASE PROVIDE ADVANCE NOTICE IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO MAKE YOUR SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT TIME.

THE PUBIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IS LIMITED TO A MAXIMUM OF FIVE (5) PEOPLE IN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT BUILDING SO IT IS IMPORTANT FOR US TO ADHERE TO THE STATE MANDATED RESTRICTIONS THAT ARE IN PLACE TO PROTECT THE HEALTH AND WELL BEING OF THE PUBLIC AND ALL FRANKLIN COUNTY STAFF.
