BACKGROUND INFORMATION

NCIC Inmate Communications currently provides secure inmate telephone and call monitoring system services in the Benton-Franklin Counties Juvenile Detention Center. This Personal Service Contract Amendment No. 2 will amend Section 2 of the Contract, per Benton County Resolution No. 2017 057 and Franklin County Resolution No. 2017 12.

SUMMARY

NCIC Inmate Communications continues to provide an inmate telecommunication system, telecommunications and maintenance services to the Detention Unit of the Benton-Franklin Counties Juvenile Justice Center. Detention Unit agrees to this Personal Service Contract Amendment No. 2. The purpose of this Amendment No. 2 is to revise Section 2 "Duration and Renewal of Contract" to extend the contract for an additional twelve (12) month period, from January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020.

RECOMMENDATION

We recommend that the Boards of County Commissioners approve the Personal Service Contract Amendment No. 2 between the Benton-Franklin Counties Juvenile Justice Center and NCIC Inmate Communications as written.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman is authorized to sign the attached NCIC Inmate Communications Personal Services Contract Amendment No. 2 in which there is no financial obligation to the Benton-Franklin Counties Juvenile Justice Center, and a 0% commission percentage on gross revenues is returned to the Counties in order to reduce communication barriers between youth and parents; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the term of the Personal Services Contract Amendment No. 2 shall commence on January 1, 2020 and shall expire on December 31, 2020.

PERSONAL SERVICE CONTRACT AMENDMENT No. 2

NCIC INMATE COMMUNICATIONS

This Contract Amendment is made and entered into by and between Benton County, a political subdivision, with its principal offices at 620 Market Street, Prosser, WA 99350 and Franklin County, a political subdivision, with its principal offices at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, WA 99301, by and for the Benton-Franklin Counties Juvenile Justice Center, a bi-county agency located at 5606 W. Canal Place STE 106, Kennewick, WA 99336 (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Counties"), and NCIC Inmate Communications with its principal office at 607 E. Whaley St., Longview, TX 75601 (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor").

In consideration of the mutual benefits and covenants contained herein and in the parties' contract, numbered as Benton County Resolution No. 2017 057 and executed on January 24, 2017, and Franklin County Resolution No. 2017-12 and executed on January 11, 2017 (the "Contract"), the parties agree to amend the Contract as follows:

1. In accordance with Section 2 of the Contract ("Duration and Renewal of Contract"), the parties agree to extend the Contract for an additional twelve (12) month period, from **January 1, 2020**, to **December 31, 2020**.

Except as expressly provided in this Contract Amendment No. 2, all other terms and conditions of the original Contract and subsequent written contract amendments thereto remain in full force and effect.

This Amendment shall be effective January 1, 2020 and shall expire December 31, 2020.
