SUBJECT: Next-Generation Antivirus Subscription	
FISCAL IMPACT: \$16,262.85 Budget Year 2021; \$7,723.97 Paid By SHSP20 Grant.	
BACKGROUND: As our current antivirus solution, AVG, expires on September 27, 2021, we seek approval to purchase a yearly subscription of Carbon Black through our reseller, CompuNet. Carbon Black is a Next-Generation Antivirus (NGAV) Software as a Service (SaaS) solution which uses a combination of artificial intelligence, behavioral detection, and exploit mitigation, so known and unknown threats can be immediately prevented on user desktops, as opposed to AVG virus detection after a computer is infected. Funding for 2021 subscription will come from 2 sources: Information Services 101350 4816 (Repair and Maintenance – Software Maintenance) fund, \$8,538.88; Emergency Management SHSP20 grant fund 63901, \$7,723.97. 101350 4816 object fund will increase by \$11,250 (\$6,000 budgeted in 2021) in budget year 2022 for the renewal of Carbon Black. Renewal cost will be requested during normal budget process.	
RECOMMENDATION: Request approval and authorization for Information Services to issue a purchase order to CompuNet for a one year subscription of Carbon Black NGAV.
