Establish participation percentage splits for Benton & Franklin Counties Selective Aggressive Probation Program, Detention Mental Health and Education Employment Training Programs based on the annual at-risk-youth population. Position allocations and percentage splits are necessary to determine the Benton & Franklin Counties Superior Court and Juvenile Court 2022 budgets.

**BEFORE THE BOARDS OF COMMISSIONERS OF BENTON AND FRANKLIN COUNTIES,
WASHINGTON:**

IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTING THE PARTICIPANT POSITION ALLOCATION FOR THE 2022 BENTON AND FRANKLIN ADULT AND JUVENILE DRUG COURT PROGRAMS; AND ADOPTING NEW AT RISK YOUTH POPULATION PERCENTAGE SPLIT FOR FUNCTIONAL FAMILY THERAPY (FFT), SELECTIVE AGGRESSIVE PROBATIONS (SAP), DETENTION MENTAL HEALTH, AND EDUCATION EMPLOYMENT TRAINING PROGRAM (EET) PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the Boards of Benton and Franklin County Commissioners approved Joint Resolution Benton County 2019-141 and Franklin County 2019-042 a Memorandum of Understanding regarding the allocation of Adult and Juvenile Drug Court and Functional Family Therapy (FFT) Programs; and

WHEREAS, Joint Resolution Benton County 2019-141 and Franklin County 2019-042 established an administrative fee of 7.5% on Franklin County’s allocation of the total 2022 Benton and Franklin Adult and Juvenile Drug Court, Functional Family Therapy (FFT), Selective Aggressive Probation (SAP), Detention Mental Health and Education Employment Training (EET) Programs Budget; and

WHEREAS, For Adult and Juvenile Drug Court and Functional Family Therapy FFT, Franklin County’s responsible amount is based upon the annual number of participant positions allocated to each county as approved through each county’s budget process, data table attached hereto as Attachment “A”, plus a 7.5% administrative fee, effective January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, For Selective Aggressive Probation (SAP), Detention Mental Health, and Education Employment Training (EET), Franklin Counties portion is based on the annual at-risk-youth population percentage split, data table attached hereto as Attachment “B”, plus a 7.5% administrative fee, effective January 1, 2022; **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED, Benton County shall invoice Franklin County monthly for the County’s pro rata share of the expenses incurred in the 2022 Benton and Franklin Adult and Juvenile Drug Court, Functional Family Therapy (FFT), Selective Aggressive Probation (SAP), Detention Mental Health, and Education Employment Training (EET) Programs Budget; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Franklin County’s payment to the Benton County Treasurer shall be no later than 20 days of the date of each invoice thereafter (February 15th invoice, for the month of January expenses, payment due March 6th), and so forth.
